Computer Equipment Program

General Summary:

The Coquille Indian Tribal Council approved a gift for supplemental Computer Equipment funding for tribal member college students. *CIT students must have been enrolled for at least two terms or semesters in order to be eligible for this program.*

1. Full-time students shall be enrolled in minimum of twelve (12) undergraduate or nine (9) graduate credit hours towards a college/university and must satisfactorily complete no fewer than the minimum credit hours per term with a minimum of 2.0 undergraduate GPA or 3.0 graduate GPA working towards a degree.
2. Part-time applicants shall be enrolled in regular accredited college/university courses in at least six (6) but fewer than twelve (12) undergraduate credit hours or fewer than nine (9) graduate credits hours which will apply towards a college/university degree and must satisfactorily complete no fewer than the minimum credit hours per term with a minimum of 2.0 undergraduate GPA.

The primary objectives of the college Computer Equipment program is to provide computer equipment so CIT students have appropriate tools to enhance their knowledge and learning capabilities.

Limitations:

The Computer Equipment funds are limited to a one-time stipend of \$1000 per college student. *The funds may be used for computer and programming purchases. Funds may not be used for training, shipping and/or maintenance of equipment.* Our budget is limited and may not meet all the needs of tribal members encountered.

Procedure for Reimbursement and Direct Payment:

1. Prior approval for all funding is mandatory. For an application go to (www.coquilletribe.org) to download an application or call or write to Education Program for an application.
2. Mail a receipt or canceled check along with the completed application to the Coquille Indian Tribe, Attention Education. If you are concerned about whether your request fits the program guidelines or how much funding has been spent you may call the CIT offices and speak to a member of the Education Staff at (800) 622-5869 Ext. 225.
3. If you are unable to pay for the equipment and would like the CIT Education Program to make a check out to an individual, business or organization directly, please mail a copy listing the equipment with prices on the business' letterhead and a receipt, if applicable. Allow at least two weeks for accounting processing.
4. If you would like the CIT administration office to help you find a computer, we would be happy to accommodate you and will need to indicate this on your application.
