### LODGING:

Families will be housed in 2 or 3 bedroom condos at Eagle Crest Resort on a first come - first serve basis (with paid registration fee). All the condos are completely furnished including fully equipped kitchens and propane BBQ's.

### ACTIVITIES:

There will be a Rafting trip for youth ages 13-18 yrs. Space is limited and registration will be on a first come first served basis. Family Camp Registration fee must be received to be eligible. Also available is the Coyote Club for children 7 - 12 yrs. Eagle Crest's staff, along with CHC staff will arrange an activity/field trip for your child to attend. A trip to Warm Springs Museum for any family that would like to register. There will be two Fun Poker Walks, Drumming & Dancing, Family Outdoor Games, Photo Archival Station, General Council meeting, a Dessert Social, Culture Presentation & Heritage Workshop, Cascadia event discussion and a Health Fair.

### HEALTH FAIR

There will be a Health Fair on Saturday, right before the dinner. Stations will include: blood pressure, blood sugar testing, Diabetes Prevention, Tobacco Education, and dental core/cavity prevention. Tribal Member Services, Librarian and Education Dept. will also be available for information.

### ELIGIBILITY:

Space and funding require Tribal Council to set eligibility requirements for attendance at Family Camp. Requirements are as follows: Tribal members and spouses, non-Coquille custodial parents of Tribal members, step or adopted children living full time in a Tribal home, and widow or widowers of members that have not remarried. ### Photo Archival Station at Culture Presentation & Heritage Workshop

In order to build the Tribe's Historic Photo archive, a station will be set up to scan family photos to preserve pictures that may be lost, protect images from damage, learn from, and educate others using family images. Come share your treasures and stories.

### REGISTRATION:

Please complete the enclosed **Registration Form** and return it along with the **Registration fee** to the CITCHC. Registration will be based on a first come- first served.

### REGISTRATION FEE

To register, a non-refundable registration fee of \$20 per person or \$40 per immediate household is required. If you are unable to pay the registration fee, and you qualify for Medicaid or OHP (or your state's equivalent), please contact Toni or Rita.

### LATE FEE:

Per Tribal Council and the Health Advisory Board approval, any registration received after the June 30th deadline will be charged an **additional \$50 fee per registration**, regardless of the circumstance. This fee is applicable to those even on Medicaid or OHP.

### PETS:

Pets are only allowed with a non-refundable deposit of approximately \$75 which you will be personally responsible for paying. There are limited pet friendly condos available so please contact Toni or Rita if you will be bringing your pet.

### NON-ELIGIBLE PERSONS:

If you would like to bring a non-eligible person, a **\$200** (per person) fee will apply.
