

OUR SAFE PLAY PLAN

Dear Friends,

We're excited to welcome you back to The Mill!

We've missed all of our friends during the closure. As we re-open, we want to let you know that we're committed to the health and safety of you, our employees and our community. Because we want you to feel comfortable playing at The Mill, we've developed a thorough set of protocols we're calling our "Safe Play Plan." This plan will assure we have a clean and safe environment for all. And while things may be a little different for a while, we're doing all we can to make sure friends like you will have as great a time at The Mill as you always have!

LIMITED HOURS & LIMITED ENTRY

- We'll be open Sunday - Thursday from 9 AM to 10 PM and Friday - Saturday 9 AM - Midnight.
- The number of people in the casino will be restricted to 300 at one time.

LIMITED AMENITIES

- Slot floor open with distancing measures.
- No table games offered initially, reintroduce with limited/distance seating.
- Food service limited to take-out from Timbers Café. Social distance seating available at Warehouse 101 and Saw Blade Buffet.
- Hotel and RV Park open with limited number of rooms/spaces and physical distancing protocols in place.

HOTEL & RV PARK

- Pool and gym facilities closed.
- RV Park restrooms, shower, yurt, propane and laundry services closed.
- Reusable guests keys will be sanitized between guest use.
- Specific sanitation consideration will be paid to all guest room areas.
- Extra pillows and blankets stored in the guest room closets will be removed and available upon request.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE MEASURES

Require use of Personal Protective Equipment by guests and employees as needed. This includes:

- Mandatory temperature testing upon entry for guests and employees.
- Face masks will be mandatory for employees in guest-facing roles.
- Face masks will be provided and voluntary for guests.
- Requiring certain employees to wear gloves.
- Once table games re-open, physical barriers will be in place between players and dealers.

SMOKING, EATING & DRINKING

- Smoking will not be restricted on casino floor at this time.
- Food service limited to take-out from Timbers Café.
- Buffet closed initially.
- Employees will wear gloves for food and drink service.

CLEANING & SANITATION

- Hand sanitizer stations, touchless when possible, will be placed throughout the property and signage will encourage everyone to sanitize and wash their hands.
- Increased number of cleaning staff on floor dedicated to regularly sanitizing all surfaces.
- Most surfaces on gaming floor will be sanitized hourly with a hospital-grade disinfectant.
- Slot machines will be sanitized between guest usages.
- Whenever possible, employees will be required to wash or sanitize hands after each guest transaction.
- When table games re-open, players will be asked to disinfect hands before they sit and when changing tables.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING

- Spacing out of slot machines on the floor, shutting down every other machine.
- Spacing of tables in Warehouse 101 when on-site.
- Once table games re-open, spacing of seats & limited seating at each table.
- Signage to encourage physical distancing practice throughout property, including discouragement of hand-shakes and physical greetings. This includes both guests and employees.
- Management will stay aware of sneezing, coughing, or contact that makes guests or employees uncomfortable. These concerning behaviors will be politely addressed by supervisors or managers and may result in guests being asked to leave.

EMPLOYEE EDUCATION & SAFETY

- Temperature checks for all employees at start of shift.
- Monitoring of absenteeism.
- Employees will be required to sanitize hands at start of each shift and after guest transactions.
- Mandatory training on prevention and recognizing symptoms.
- Back of house signage to remind employees of the proper way to wear, handle and dispose of masks and gloves, how to correctly wash and sanitize hands, and encourage physical distancing.
- PPE, including clean masks and gloves, will be provided to each employee who comes into contact with guests.

This plan will change based on evolving conditions. We'll keep you informed of any changes to the plan as we move forward. We ask you to be an active participant in keeping The Mill a safe and fun place for all to enjoy.
