### **CIHA's Common Scheme Restriction Policy:**

"All parking, other than in the driveway or garage, must be on the side of the street where the streetlights are and must NOT exceed 24 hours."

In addition, "No tent structure, camper, recreational vehicle, motorcycle, trail bike, snowmobile, boat, trailer, motor coach, or mobile home, or any structure of any kind shall be parked, placed, erected, or used upon the property."

\* If you are parking in the yard, please move your vehicle to the driveway or a graveled area beside your house.

\* CIHA has a few storage lot spaces available on a first-come, first-served basis. The storage lot is secure and is free to use for Kilkich renters and homebuyers. There is a monthly fee for private purchase homeowners.

The common scheme policy applies to all homes on Tribal Lands. Please be respectful of the property and landscape and do not park on the grass. Help keep Kilkich beautiful.

Parking violation letters will be mailed out in May 2022.
