Items NOT allowed in the dumpsters include, but are not limited to the following:

- antifreeze
- appliances
- batteries
- digital devices
- electronics
- motor oil
- tires
- paint/solvents

Please recycle items that can be recycled. Current recycling rules allow **ONLY** the following items in the **RECYCLING** dumpster.

- Brown corrugated cardboard -

**flattened**

- Plastics #1 and #2 - **BOTTLENECK only**. No lids, yogurt, butter, cottage cheese containers, etc.
- Magazines and newspapers
- White copy paper - **NO colored paper, junk mail, envelopes**
- Metal cans - clean and rinsed (no food residue); no lids

Mowers, string trimmers, and a carpet shampooer are available to borrow (if available). Call CIHA a day in advance to reserve.

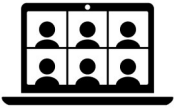
