Items NOT allowed in the dumpsters include, but are not limited to the following:

- electronics

- tires
- paint/solvents

Please recycle items that can be recycled. Current recycling rules allow ONLY the following items in the RECYCLING dumpster.

Brown corrugated cardboard -

flattened

- Plastics #1 and #2 BOTTLENECK only. No lids, yogurt, butter, cottage cheese containers, etc.
- Magazines and newspapers
- White copy paper NO colored paper, junk mail, envelopes
- Metal cans clean and rinsed (no food residue); no lids

today (available for both Android and iOS devices). The app allows you to receive real-time weather alerts, send notifications to loved ones, locate emergency shelters in your area, and much more. FEMA

The app will help you plan basic preparedness strategies, create a family emergency communication plan, tells you what to pack in your emergency kit, and what to do immediately after a disaster. The app also connects you with FEMA's disaster resources should you experience a disaster and helps you find available help.
