SUPPLEMENTAL COURT RULES 2008-1

ADOPTION OF 2004 OREGON STATE BAR FORMS & PROCEDURES FOR
GUARDIANSHIPS, CONSERVATORSHIPS, AND TRANSFERS TO MINORS

Coquille Indian Tribal Code, Chapter 375, being silent concerning certain forms and procedures for the administration of guardianships, conservatorships and transfers to minors,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that where the laws and procedures of the Coquille Indian Tribe are silent, the Coquille Indian Tribal Court adopts the forms, procedures and provisions of the most current edition of the Oregon State Bar Continuing Legal Education Manual entitled "Guardianships, Conservatorships, and Transfers to Minors"; provided, however, that submissions and orders in this court shall be adapted to incorporate reference to the laws of the Coquille Indian Tribe rather than to the laws of the State of Oregon or other jurisdictions.
