

LIHEAP is a federal program that offers financial assistance to qualifying low income households to help pay energy bills. This assistance is provided through the Department of Health and Human Services. Both renters and homeowners are eligible for LIHEAP.

The amount of financial assistance a household is eligible to receive from LIHEAP is based

Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program Begins October 1, 2018

on household size, income, documented energy costs, and other factors in the current program year. Under federal law, to be eligible for LIHEAP, the household income must be at or below 60 percent of Oregon's median income.

LIHEAP payments are made directly to the energy provider.

If you received LIHEAP assistance last year, an application will be mailed to you. If you did

NOT receive LIHEAP funding last year, or if your address has changed, you will need to pick up an application at Oregon Coast Community Action (ORCCA), 1855 Thomas Ave., (off of LaClair Street) Coos Bay, 541-435-7080, or at one of Coos County's libraries: www.cooslibraries.org.

If you need copies made to go with your LIHEAP application, stop by the CIHA office during normal office hours.

Follow the signs to Allegany. The ranch is 13 miles east of Coos Bay on the Coos river directly across the road from the Allegany post office/community center. Come pick out your favorite pumpkin, get lost in the Corn Maze or Hay Maze, try out the Mole Hill Slide, visit the animals, and shop in the gift shop. There is a nominal fee for some of the listed activities; call for pricing, 541-269-3900. Visa and MasterCard accepted. **NO pets and NO smoking allowed on property. Children 12 and under MUST be accompanied by a paying adult.** Mahaffy Ranch is wheelchair accessible.
Hours: Monday through Friday, 12 PM - 5 PM; Saturday and Sunday, 10 AM - 6 PM.

The CIHA Board recently approved new CIHA maintenance rates. These rates become effective October 1, 2018.

All rates are charged per hour with a one hour minimum.

- General Repair Labor Rate \$48 per hour
- Garbage Clean-Up \$48 per hour
- Lawn Maintenance \$48 per hour
- Lock Changes \$48 per hour
- Service Call for No Key \$48 per hour
- Garbage Can Haul Away \$24 each can
- Duplicate Keys Made \$12 each key



Returned check charge remains at \$35 for each returned check plus any additional bank fees.

The late fee for housing payments remains at \$50. Housing payments are due on the 1st day of every month and are late if not paid by the close of business on the 5th day of every month.
