CIHA's 9th Annual Renter Front Yard Makeover Drawing Entries Due to CIHA by 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 25th



CIHA is sponsoring the Renter Front Yard Make-over Drawing again this year. The winning entry will be drawn at the July 25th CIHA Board meeting. If you lease a low rent single-family home from CIHA and are NOT living in a unit that has had a front yard makeover in the past, you are eligible to enter the Renter Front Yard Makeover Drawing.

Annual July 3rd Fireworks Over The Bay



Come out and bring the whole family to enjoy an evening of incredible fireworks and fun.



Coquille Tribal Lands Fireworks Ordinance



 Only those fireworks allowed by the State of Oregon are approved for use on Tribal Lands.



- Official holidays during which fireworks may be ignited are the 4th of July and New Years Day.
- 4. Any person under the age of eighteen must have the immediate supervision of an adult.
- Improper or unsafe use will result in the confiscation of all fireworks in the possession of the person by Tribal Police.

- 6. Tribal officials may make subsequent restrictions on the use of fireworks based on public safety, weather conditions, and fire concerns.
- 7. In addition, and not in lieu of any other penalty allowed by law, a \$50 assessment shall be paid to the Coquille Indian Housing Authority by any person found in violation of this ordinance."
