

TITLE VI POLICY STATEMENT

Coquille Indian Tribe Civil Rights

The Coquille Indian Tribe Transportation Program CITTP is committed to complying with the requirements of Title VI, in all of its programs and activities, and will not permit any discrimination in its public service and accommodations, based on race, color, sex, national origin, or any other protected classification.

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 states:

"No person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance."

YOUR RIGHTS UNDER TITLE VI COQUILLE INDIAN TRIBE (CIT)

- The CIT operates its transportation program and services without regard to race, color, or national origin in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act. Any person who believes they have been aggrieved by any unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI may file a complaint with the CIT Health Clinic.

Making a Title VI Complaint

Any person who believes he or she has been distressed by an unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI may file a complaint with the Coquille Indian Tribe. Any such complaint must be in writing and filed with The Coquille Indian Tribe with 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence.
