Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) Helps Households Pay

LIHEAP is a federal program that offers financial assistance to qualifying low income households to help pay energy costs, such as heat and electric bills. This assistance is provided through the Department of Health and Human Services.

Both renters and homeowners are eligible for LIHEAP.

The amount of financial energy assistance a household is eligible to receive from LIHEAP is determined by household composition, household income, documented energy costs, and other factors in the current program year. Under federal law, to be eligible for LIHEAP, the household income must be at or below 60 percent of Oregon's median income.

LIHEAP payments are made directly to the energy provider.

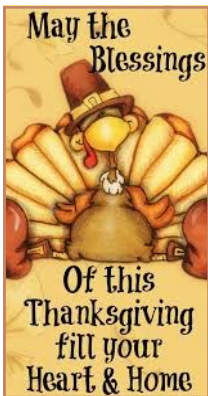
