WHEREAS, Native Americans have enriched our heritage and continue to add to all aspects of our society through their generosity of culture and the continued practice of teaching economic, environmental, and cultural sustainability; and

WHEREAS, in celebration of Native American Heritage Month, wishes to encourage everyone to join in recognition of the accomplishments and contributions the Native American community has made to our society and salute all of the local organizations who work with and in support of the Native American community.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Joe Benetti, Mayor of the City of Coos Bay, do hereby proclaim the month of November as

“NATIVE AMERICAN HERITAGE MONTH”

and urge all citizens to join in this special observance and recognize the history, culture, contributions, and achievements of Native Americans throughout our community.
