Charleston Sanitary District To Raise Rates \$2.50 Effective July 1, 2022

CIHA has been notified that the Charleston Sanitary District will raise their sewer rates \$2.50 on July 1, 2022. Your current rate of \$75 will increase to \$77.50. There is an additional proposed rate increase of \$2.50 to become effective January 1, 2023. If you use payroll deduct, you will receive new payroll deduct paperwork from CIHA. This rate increase is NOT a CIHA rate increase. CIHA bills for the Charleston Sanitary District on a monthly basis.
