

DETOUR UPDATE

Beginning Monday, July 10th, the Coos Bay North Bend Water Board will be installing a new main line and hydrant on Mexeye Loop, to the north of the Kilkich administrative building. This installation will cause the detour through the administration parking lot to be closed for several days. During this closure, traffic will need to utilize Miluk Drive to access Mexeye Loop. The detour is expected to reopen Thursday, July 13th. Parking in the lot will not be affected.

CHARTER OUTAGE

Next week will cause a bit more disruption than usual. Ziply, Douglas Fast Net (DFN), and Charter will be working on communication lines.

Beginning Monday, July 10th, the contractors will move the communication conduits and pedestal box to its new location. This work will cause a <u>Charter service outage for approximately 3 hours, sometime between 8am and 4pm on the 10th,</u> while they splice the new line in. All other networks will NOT have an expected service outage.
