KILKICH TRANSPORTATION SAFETY PROJECT Weekly Update • July 7, 2023



CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Concrete pours in the closure area are finishing up this week. Work continued in the Learning Center parking lot, prepping for new lights, catch basins, sidewalks, and asphalt.

WHAT TO EXPECT NEXT WEEK

Next week will cause a bit more disruption than usual. Ziplly, Douglas Fast Net (DFN), and Charter will be working on communication lines.

Beginning Monday, July 10th, the contractors will move the communication conduits and pedestal box to its new location. This work will cause a Charter service outage for approximately 3 hours, sometime between 8am and 4pm on the 10th, while they splice the new line in. All other networks will NOT have an expected service outage.

Also beginning Monday, the 10th, the Coos Bay North Bend Water Board will be installing a new main line and hydrant on Mexeye Loop, to the north of the Kilkich administrative building. This installation will cause the detour through the administration parking lot to be closed for several days. See "Road Closures & Detours" for more information.

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION EFFORTS

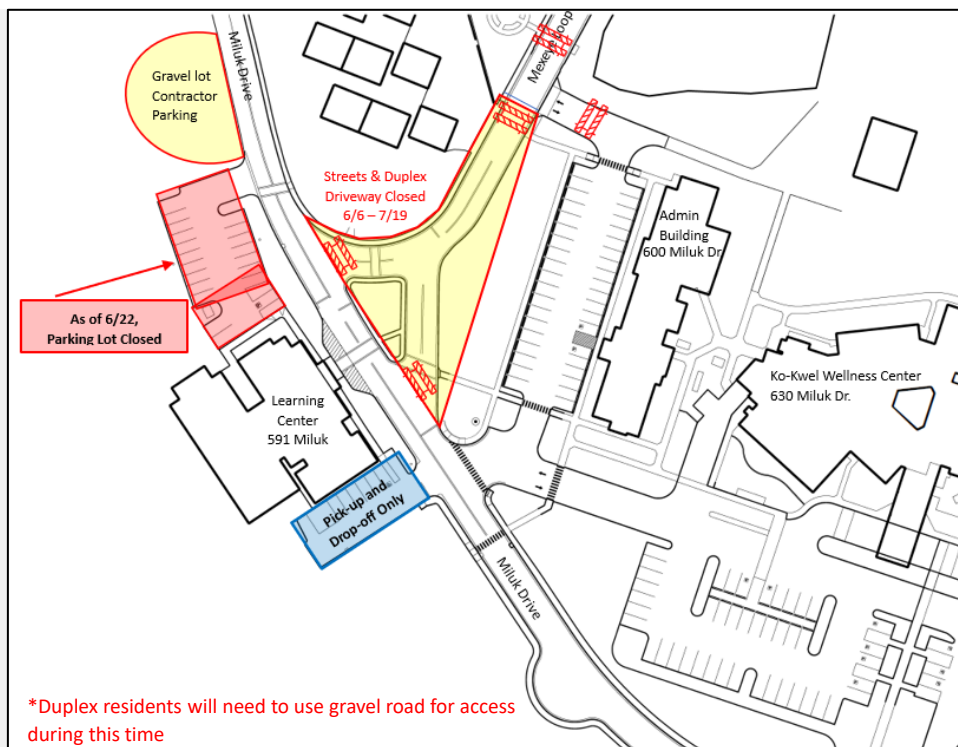
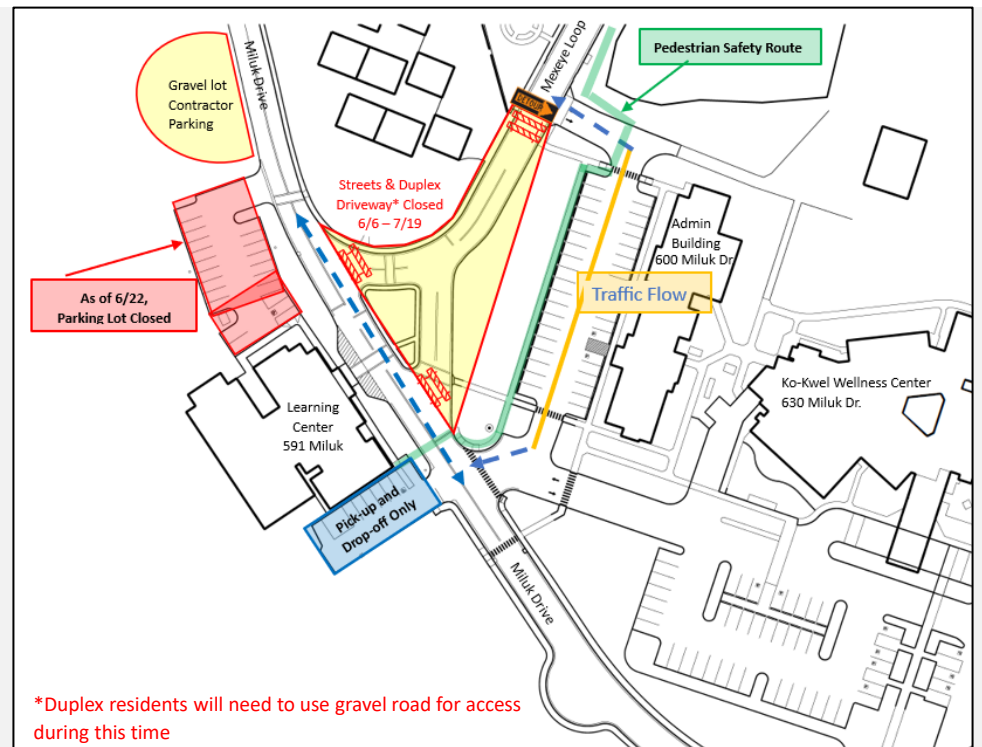
The environmental controls are being monitored throughout each day by the contractor, PMO and NRO staff. The roadways will be swept and cleaned each Friday before the weekend.

ROAD CLOSURES & DETOURS

Beginning June 5th, Mexeye Loop was closed in the area highlighted in yellow to the right. The road is expected to reopen July 19th. Barricades are installed and a detour is in place. The detour guides traffic off Miluk Drive/Mexeye Loop through the Kilkich Administration Building parking lot.

The parking lot to the west of the Learning Center (in red) is closed as of June 22nd. The parking lot to the east of the Learning Center (in blue) will be for student pick-up and drop-off only.

All staff and visitors that need to park longer than 15 minutes, please utilize parking across the street in the KWC parking lot.



CLOSURE ALERT

Beginning Monday, July 10th, The detour through the Kilkich Administration Building Lot will be closed during and after business hours This closure will last through Wednesday, July 12th.

During this closure, traffic will need to utilize Miluk Drive to access Mexeye Loop.

The detour is expected to reopen Thursday, July 13th. Parking in the lot will not be affected.
