WATER OUTAGE REMINDER

The Coos Bay North Bend Waterboard has a planned water outage from 5:00-8:00am on Friday, July 28th. The outage will affect the six residences to the east of the Learning Center on Miluk Drive. The outage will not affect the regular opening of Tribal businesses at Kilkich.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES


Phase 2 work continued with continued excavation of the curbs, gutters, sidewalks, asphalt and ADA ramps near the Learning Center. Shrubs and brush were removed, and the cultural rocks were safely relocated.

WHAT TO EXPECT NEXT WEEK

Excavation, excavation, excavation. Civil work will continue near the Learning Center. The new curbs, gutters, sidewalks, and ADA ramps will be formed and prepped for new concrete. Towards the end of the week, these forms will be poured and finished.

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION EFFORTS

The environmental controls are being monitored throughout each day by the contractor, PMO and NRO staff. The roadways will be swept and cleaned each Friday before the weekend. The fledged eaglet is learning to hunt! It's sibling however is still happily napping in the nest.



NEW ROAD CLOSURE & DETOUR

The area of Miluk Drive, highlighted in yellow above, is currently closed and barricaded.

The detour in place guides traffic off Miluk Drive onto Mexeye Loop and through the Killich Administration Building parking lot. This detour is expected to remain in place through mid-August.

The parking lot to the west of the Learning Center (in red) will remain closed. The parking lot to the east of the Learning Center (in blue) will be for student pick-up and drop-off only.

All staff and visitors that need to park longer than 15 minutes, please utilize parking across the street in the KWC parking lot.
