CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES


This week was heavy on excavation and grading of the Learning Center parking lot. Lots of sidewalks, curbs, and gutters were formed and poured. The driveway approach in front of the duplex was also paved for use!

WHAT TO EXPECT NEXT WEEK

Brock Construction will continue work on the new curbs, gutters, sidewalks, and ADA ramps around the roadway and in the parking lot. They will also start forming the new fence footings in the Learning Center courtyard and hopefully at the end of the week install new topsoil.

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION EFFORTS

The environmental controls are being monitored throughout each day by the contractor, PMO and NRO staff. The roadways will be swept and cleaned each Friday before the weekend. Water trucks are doing their best to keep the dust down.



ROAD CLOSURES & DETOURS

We are still in that Phase 2 detour. The detour guides traffic off Miluk Drive onto Mexeye Loop and through the Kilkich Administration Building parking lot and back onto Miluk Drive. We will see flaggers, as noted in the image above, on Monday, August 21^{st} , and Wednesday, August 23^{rd} .

The parking lot to the west of the Learning Center (in red) will remain closed. The parking lot to the east of the Learning Center (in blue) will be for student pick-up and drop-off only.

All staff and visitors that need to park longer than 15 minutes, please utilize parking across the street in the KWC parking lot.
