Kilkich Resident Holiday Credits Awarded

December brings a holiday credit to each household on Tribal Lands again this year. The holiday credit will be paid by check, a credit adjustment on your December billing statement, or a combination of check and credit adjustment.

The holiday credits paid by check will be mailed to you in December.

The holiday credit ranges from \$75 to \$250. Holiday credits are awarded based on the following compliance criteria:

- Payments made in FULL and on time each month. Payments are due by the 5th of every month and are late on the 6th of every month.
- No utility shutoff notices. This includes power, water, and garbage.
- All paperwork requests must be returned to CIHA within 30 days.
- Pass your annual household inspection.
- Have no actionable neighborhood complaints.
- Have no yard notices.

PUBLIC SAFETY BULLETIN

SCINT ASSISTS TRIBAL POLICE OFFICER CRYSTAL WALLING WITH ILLEGAL GROW



On November 20th, 2024, Coos County Sheriff's Office South Coast Interagency Narcotics Team "SCINT" Detective B. Davis assisted Coquille Tribal Police Officer C. Walling with an investigation into an illegal marijuana operation located at 93661 Green Acres Ln, Coos Bay, Coos County, Oregon. A search warrant was granted for the residence and Coos County Sheriff's Office executed the search warrant later that day.

CCSO Deputies and Detectives on scene located a substantial operation with about 100 marijuana plants, eight firearms, and about \$3,000.00 in U.S currency. This marijuana operation was found to be set up to generate hundreds of thousands of un-taxed dollars over time if sold. The Oregon Water Master and Coos County code enforcement were also contacted and currently investigating violations found on scene.



Puppies, Kittens, and Policy

It is tempting to bring home an adorable kitten or puppy to surprise your child or family this Christmas, but pets are NOT allowed on Tribal Lands in rental units. If you have a prescription for a companion animal, the animal MUST be up-to-date on all vaccinations and spayed/neutered.

Vaccination records and proof of the spay/neuter must be submitted to CIHA.

Companion animals must be approved by CIHA BEFORE they are added to the household. S/Nipped in Empire, 541-808-2377, offers low-cost spay and neuter services.

NOVEMBER KILKICH PEST CONTROL WILL TAKE PLACE

FRIDAY, DECEMBER 6, 2024, BETWEEN 9:00 A.M. AND NOON

Organic Pest Control will treat all odd numbered homes around the loop, including the homes in Jistajaya Court and the private purchase homes along Miluk Drive. The homes to be treated are rental and HomeGO units and subscribing private purchase homes.

As a reminder:

- There is no reason for you to vacate your home during exterior treatments.
- We advise keeping windows and doors closed during treatments.
- Please keep children and pets inside during treatments.
- Children and pets may go outside immediately following treatments.
- All regularly scheduled service will take place around the exterior of your home.
- If you want inside work performed, please contact us at least two days prior to the scheduled treatment.

(Most interior services require that you vacate your home during treatment hours.)

- This is the only notice you will receive regarding your scheduled pest control treatment.
