**Housing assistance** – Tribal housing programs help low-income Tribal families achieve and maintain housing stability through a variety of assistance programs.

Current services:

- Affordable rental and homebuyer housing at Kilkich
- Emergency assistance with rent, utilities, temporary housing, deposits, and similar costs within the Tribe's service area
- Tenant-based rental assistance nationwide
- Homeowner assistance for home repairs necessary to protect the health and safety of the home's occupants nationwide
- Homeowner assistance to install a heat pump and associated upgrades in Oregon
- Support for the Kilkich Residents Association, Tribal Elders, and Tribal Police Department at Kilkich

Recent activities:

- Completed rehabilitation of three low-income rental units to accessible design standards at Kilkich
- Conducted financial wellness training for CIHA program participants at The Mill
- Brush clearing and vegetation management near Mexeye Loop housing lot lines and in CIHA common areas at Kilkich
- Provided pass through financial support from the State of Oregon to the local community to reduce homelessness in Coos County

In the works:

- Roofing rehabilitation at Kilkich
- Solar panels for duplex units at Kilkich
- New benches and school bus stop at Kilkich
- New electric lawn equipment for residents to use at Kilkich
- First-time homebuyer assistance program to help with down payment and closing costs in Oregon
- Construction of three new low-income rental units to accommodate mobility impairments accessible design standards at Kilkich
