## MONTHLY UPDATE – FEBRUARY 2025

The Kilkich Area Plan is moving steadily forward, with meaningful progress across technical work, agency coordination, and the development of upcoming opportunities for community involvement. We're excited to begin shifting toward deeper engagement with Tribal membership as the project enters its next phase.

Our consultant team at 3J Consulting, Walker Macy, Kittleson and Associates, and Leland Consulting have started drafting the first set of technical memorandums that will form the foundation of the Kilkich Area Plan. These documents will address key topics, including existing site conditions, land-use patterns, infrastructure and utility systems, environmental considerations, and early opportunities and constraints. Together, they will support thoughtful decision-making for the long-term wellbeing and resilience of the Kilkich community.

## MONTHLY UPDATE – FEBRUARY 2025 (CONT'D)

Our first agency open house was held on March 4 to strengthen communication with local and regional partners. Planning department representatives from utility companies, service providers, and municipalities were invited to join us to share insights and help identify coordination needs early in the planning process. We are thankful for the community's support and coordination on this project.

The next Steering Committee meeting is scheduled for March 30. During this meeting, the committee will begin developing seven preliminary alternatives informed by the technical memorandums and the results of early interviews and the first Steering Committee meeting. These alternatives will serve as the basis for future community review conversations. The Steering Committee will preview a community engagement plan and provide feedback, which we hope to review in early April at a Tribal Council workshop.

Please look for more information about Tribal citizen engagement around the April Tribal Council workshop schedule, when we plan to share the Community Engagement Plan and seek feedback from Tribal Council. Early engagement will look like bringing awareness to the project, with interactive engagement starting closer to June and lasting throughout the summer into early fall. We plan to start by offering an opportunity to provide feedback at any time on the Coquille Tribe website.
