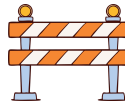
Housing payment pick up is available for elders and people with a disability. Call CIHA to schedule a payment pick up at (541) 888-6501.

## LAWN MOWERS AND STRING TRIMMERS AVAILABLE TO BORROW

Spring rains, warm temperatures, and intermittent sunshine can make the grass and weeds grow like crazy. If your yard needs attention, CIHA has lawn mowers and string trimmers available to borrow for up to 24 hours. Reserve a day in advance by calling CIHA at (541) 888-6501.

Equipment is loaned on a first come, first served basis.

If you have a large amount of organic yard material (clippings, leaves, etc.) to dispose of, you can request CIHA's dump trailer to put the yard debris in. The trailer will be parked at your house for up to 24 hours. You are responsible for loading your own yard debris into the trailer.
