CREATE DEFENSIBLE SPACE

- Clear dry grass, brush, and debris around your home
- Keep roofs and gutters free of leaves and needles
- Trim tree branches away from roofs and power lines



PREPARE FOR EVACUATION

- Pack a go-bag with medications, important documents, food, and water
- Know multiple evacuation routes from your neighborhood
- Sign up for emergency alerts and monitor local updates



PREVENT HUMAN-CAUSED FIRES

- Fully extinguish campfires
- Do not park vehicles on dry grass
- Properly dispose of cigarettes and smoking materials
- Use spark arrestors on equipment and trailers



PROTECT YOUR PROPERTY

- Store firewood away from structures
- Use nonflammable landscaping near buildings
- Keep driveways accessible for emergency vehicles



KNOW THE OREGON EVACUATION LEVELS



LEVEL 1 BE READY

Stay alert and be prepared.



LEVEL 2 BE SET

Get set to leave at a moment's notice.



LEVEL 3 GO NOW

Leave immediately. It's not safe to wait.
